

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AN ORDINANCE WHICH PROMULGATED RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING AMBULANCE SERVICE IN SURRY COUNTY, THE GRANTING OF A FRANCHISE FOR AMBULANCE SERVICE, AND PROVIDING OF SUPPLEMENTS THEREFOR, WHICH ORDINANCE WAS ADOPTED BY THE SURRY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON MARCH 1, 1972, RECORDED IN COMMISSIONERS' MINUTE BOOK 11, AT PAGE 96 & 97.

The Board of Commissioners of Surry County, North Carolina, do hereby enact and ordain:

Section 1. The ordinance adopted by the Board of Commissioners of Surry County on March 1, 1972, and recorded in Commissioners' Minute Book 11, at Page 96 & 97, of the records of the Surry County Board of Commissioners promulgating rules and regulations governing ambulance service, and providing of supplements therefor, is hereby repealed together with all resolutions enacted after March 1, 1972, concerning the setting of fees for ambulance service.

Section 2. All ordinances and resolutions and clauses of ordinances and resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.
