Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Surry County that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the Capital Project Ordinance adopted by the Board on November 18, 1991, and amended on September 8, 1992, is amended as follows:

Delete Section 3 from the Ordinance as amended on September 8, 1992.

Add the following Section:

Section 3. The following revenues are anticipated to be available to complete this project:

Capital Reserve Fund	\$ 2,666,590.
General Fund	1,167,811.
Other Sources	0
Total Revenues	<u>\$ 3,834,401.</u>

Delete Section 4. from the Ordinance as amended on September 8, 1992.

Add the following Section:

Section 4. The following amounts are appropriated for the project:

Construction: Administration/Social Services Building	\$ 3,246,200.
Construction: Emergency Services Building	278,426.
Professional Fees	196,600.
Prints/Reimbursables	16,600.
Survey/Testing	18,050.
Contingency	78,525.
Total	<u>\$ 3,834,401.</u>
