I. PICNIC SHELTERS

Available for rental are two large shelters and three small shelters from which to choose.

II. FIELDS

*Available for reservation are three baseball/softball fields (one 325' field with a pitching mound and two 300' fields) and one (regulation size) soccer field and one PeeWee Soccer field all of which are **NOT** lighted at the present time.*

Lined fields are - \$10.00 per field per game.

Unlined fields are - \$5.00 per field per practice.

Parking is available within the arena area. If additional parking is needed after park hours, please notify our office at the time of registration to add a fee of \$14.00 per hour for personnel overtime. *Admission Fees or Pre-event ticket sales of any kind may not be charges with out approval from the Surry County Parks, Recreation & Maintenance Department (a minimum of 10% may be charged).

IV. GENERAL INFORMATION

Surry County Government agencies requesting use of facilities will be at no charge.

Groups reserving park facilities must register with the Surry County Parks & Recreation Department by signing the proper forms and providing payment. Groups reserving fields and dates for tournaments and/or special events must also provide proof of insurance coverage at the time of reservation. Persons reserving the shelters or fields must be 21 years of age or older. Groups using park facilities will abide by all Fisher River Park Rules and Regulations and will be given a copy prior to use.

The Surry County Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to prioritize scheduling in the following manner. First consideration is given to departmental or county sponsored activities, events and programs; then affiliated organized youth leagues; and then organized adult leagues.

Park reservation fees are non-refundable. Every effort will be made to schedule an alternate date should a cancellation become necessary. Alternate dates may or may not be available depending upon other reservations that have been confirmed. In case of inclement weather, the park user has two working days to call and schedule an alternate date within one year of original reservation date.

Fisher River Park Operating Hours:

April 1 – September 30: 8:00am – 9:00pm Daily

October 1 – March 31: 8:00am – 6:00pm Daily

Fisher River Park will be closed each year on Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Gates are locked at closing daily.

Fisher River Park features 3 baseball/softball fields (one 325' field with a pitching mound and two 300' fields), a regulation size soccer field, a pee wee soccer field, 1 ½ mile of wooded walking trails, ¼-mile paved walking track, Amphitheater, picnic shelters, Sensory Garden, horse arena, playground equipment for children ages 2 –5 and equipment for children ages 5-12, horseshoe pits, a sand volleyball court, concessions and clean public restrooms. The Park is staffed and a park attendant will be available to assist you. Call for Reservations.
