

RECRUITMENT ANNOUNCEMENT

Surry County Emergency Medical Services is accepting applications for temporary part-time Advanced EMT's and Paramedics. Employees serving in these positions perform advanced pre-hospital medical care, serve as part of a two-member ambulance crew and are responsible for medical care administered to patients. The current annual call volume is approximately 26,000. The Emergency Medical Services operates 8 ALS ambulances 24 hours each day from four satellite stations throughout a 538 square mile area and has a 24/72 work schedule.

Job requirements: The position requires a high school diploma or GED and the completion of all required courses for NC Advanced EMT or Paramedic credential, ACLS, PALS and CPR. Two years' experience as an Advanced EMT or Paramedic is desirable. Job offer will be contingent upon a negative drug test and successful background check. The successful applicant must be insurable under the County's automobile insurance at regular rates, able to complete a standard physical ability test and able to comply with currently established dress codes. A copy of the current dress code is available upon request.

Personnel training requirements: All training standards will be reviewed and monitored by the Training Division of Emergency Services. Certified personnel will be responsible for maintaining certifications to qualify as an employee with the Service. Part-time staff will be allowed to train within courses and classes provided by the training staff and must provide proper documentation of current certification levels. The successful applicant must be insurable under the County's automobile insurance at regular rates and able to comply with established dress codes. Job offer will be contingent upon a negative drug test and successful background check.

Job Requirements - Advanced EMT or Paramedic: High School diploma (or equivalent), completion of the 256-hour Advanced EMT or completion of the 1,096-hour EMT-Paramedic course, valid Advanced EMT or Paramedic credentials issued by the NC Office of EMS. CPR certification, ACLS, and PALS are required.

Hours: Personnel are required to work a minimum of 24 hours monthly and a minimum of 1 weekend shift per month.

Beginning Hiring Salary Range: \$14.23/hr. – \$16.14/hr. (dependent upon experience and credential level)
