DROP-IN SESSIONS PLANNED TO REVIEW AND COMMENT ON TRANSPORTATION PRIORITIES FOR DAVIE, STOKES, SURRY, AND YADKIN COUNTIES

The North Carolina Department of Transportation has published a ranked list of transportation priorities based upon a variety of roadway data including congestion, travel times, safety, and accessibility. Projects from all modes of transportation serving local and regional needs will have public input—highway, bicycle, pedestrian, public transportation, aviation, and rail. The Northwest Piedmont Rural Planning Organization (RPO) invites you to participate in the County Advisory Committee Meetings for Transportation Priorities. The purpose of the meetings is to review and rank transportation projects for consideration by the Northwest Piedmont RPO for inclusion in the North Carolina Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Public input during these meetings may affect the selection of a project for funding.
