

## RECRUITMENT ANNOUNCEMENT

The County of Surry is accepting applications for **TEMPORARY PART-TIME PARK ATTENDANTS** to work with the Parks and Recreation Department. The duties will include general maintenance of the Fisher River Park property and other sites such as river accesses and trails, including, but not limited to: opening and closing the park facility; maintenance of park shelters and areas at other sites, turf, and playground areas; inspections and maintenance of the grounds and athletic fields; custodial/cleaning responsibilities including restrooms and trash removal. The positions will report directly to the Parks Supervisor and indirectly to the Parks and Recreation Director. Performs other duties as assigned. Work schedule and average number of hours per week will vary.

**JOB REQUIREMENTS:** Applicants must be able to operate a leaf blower and lawn mower. Applicants should be able to lift up to 50 pounds frequently and over 50 pounds often. Knowledge and experience of construction, general buildings and grounds maintenance, and equipment repairs desired, but not required. A flexible work schedule will be required and at times will be required to work weekends, night hours, and holidays. The ability to communicate effectively and courteously with the public is essential. Graduation from high school or GED desired. Applicants must have a valid driver's license and be insurable under the County's automobile insurance at regular rates. Must be able to present professional image to the public in appearance and conduct.
