## PUBLIC NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL ELECTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Surry County Board of Elections, North Carolina that:

An election is to be held in the City of Mount Airy, NC on November 7, 2017. The City of Mount Airy will be electing a Mayor and two Commissioners; one Commissioner for the North Ward and one Commissioner for the South Ward. The polls will be open from 6:30am until 7:30pm.

Voters who are already registered to vote need not re-register. Residents who are not registered to vote must register by Oct. 13, 2017 to be eligible to vote in this election. Also, a voter who wishes to make a change to their existing voter registration must do so by the same date. A person may register to vote or make changes to their current registration at the Board of Elections office at 201 E Kapp St. in Dobson between 8:15am and 5:00pm, Mon. - Fri., or by obtaining a mail in registration form from our office, any public library or downloading and printing one at www.co.surry.nc.us.

Any voter may vote by absentee ballot beginning on Oct. 6. Application must be made on an official state application form. Forms may be obtained by contacting our office or downloaded from our web site at www.co.surry.nc.us. Completed forms may be returned in person, by fax to 336-401-8228, by signed and scanned email attachment to elections@co.surry.nc.us or mailed to the Surry County Board of Elections, P.O. Box 372, Dobson, NC 27017. The deadline for applying for an absentee ballot by mail is 5:00pm Oct. 31. A voter with an illness or physical disability or their near relative or verifiable legal guardian may request in person after 5:00pm on the Tues. prior to the election, but not later than 5:00pm on the day before the election.

One Stop absentee voting in the Board of Elections office begins Oct. 19, and ends Nov. 4, at 1:00pm. Hours are Mon.-Fri. 8:15am to 5:00pm and Sat., Nov 4, from 8:15am - 1:00pm. A satellite One Stop absentee voting site will be at the Mount Airy Municipal Building – lower level, 300 S. Main Street, Mount Airy, NC with hours of operation being Wed., Nov. 1 through Fri., Nov. 3 from 8:30am until 8:00pm. Sat., Nov. 4, the hours will be 8:30am until 1:00pm. Persons wishing to register and vote after the registration deadline may appear in person at a One Stop absentee voting site, complete the voter registration application form and provide proof of residence by presenting valid documents showing current name and address.

The Surry County Board of Elections will meet at their office at 201 E. Kapp St., Dobson, NC on Nov. 17, 2017 at 11:00am to canvass the election and certify results.
