

## RECRUITMENT ANNOUNCEMENT

The County of Surry is accepting applications for an **Opioid Response Director**. This position will provide leadership and direction to Surry County's Opioid Response efforts. The employee will coordinate planning of activities based on identified community needs and use a variety of methods and strategies to implement these goals. The employee will serve as a Countywide resource and will know and understand programs and services available in the County as they relate to Opioid abuse. The employee will be responsible for the evaluation and outcomes of the strategies implemented and research and identify County and community resource funding opportunities. The director will also work with the Board appointed Opioid Response Advisory Council. Work is performed under the general supervision of the County Manager.

**Education and Experience:** Five years experience in a leadership position preferably law enforcement or health and human services. This position should have vast experience in relationship/coalition building, leading substantial programs, and working knowledge of laws and legal/court systems in Surry County. This position should have experience collaborating with medical professionals, strategic planning, and be a self-starter. Applicants should have the ability to communicate effectively, written and orally; the ability to deal tactfully with the public; and have good organizational, administrative, and personnel management skills. Experience in budget management, grants and contract writing is also desired.
