The Surry County Board of Elections met in their office at 915 E. Atkins Street, Dobson, NC, on Tuesday February 11, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.

The board reviewed the minutes of the February 18, 2020 meeting. Minutes were approved as presented.

The director made a recommendation to approve all properly executed absentee requests received and to approve all properly executed container return envelopes received for the March 3, 2020 Primary. 18 container return envelopes were presented. One military ballot and 17 civilian ballots were reviewed. All were approved as presented. The envelopes were opened, and the ballots ran through the tabulator.

The director shared a formal complaint filed with State Board of Elections Office filed by Elbert Elvis as it relates to campaign finance violations that he believes has occurred with the Committee to Elect Todd Harris.

The director presented the board with petition forms signed for and unaffiliated candidate by petition. Wendy Carriker has collected 125 signatures for the District D seat on the Mount Airy City School Board. Board of Elections staff have qualified 114 of the 125 signatures. The board certified Wendy Carriker as an Unaffiliate Candidate by Petition for the District D seat of Mount Airy City Board of Education. The motion made was to approve and certify the qualified signatures in answer to Wendy Carriker's petition; certifying Wendy Carriker as an Unaffiliated candidate for District seat D on the Mount Airy City School Board per G.S. 163-122 (a) 4 and G.S. 163-296 showing 1.5% of signatures. The motion received a second and it passed by unanimous vote.

Having no other business, the meeting adjourned at 5:15 p.m.
