RECRUITMENT ANNOUNCEMENT

Surry County Emergency Medical Services is accepting applications for a full-time Paramedics and temporary part-time EMT's, Advanced EMT's and Paramedics. Employees serving in these positions will perform basic and/or advanced pre-hospital medical care, serve as part of a two-member ambulance crew and are responsible for medical care administered to the patient. The current annual call volume is approximately 14,000. Surry County Emergency Medical Services currently operates 8 ALS ambulances 24 hours daily from four satellite stations and 2 BLS ambulances daily from 2 satellite stations throughout a 538-square mile area.

Job Requirements: These positions require a high school diploma or GED and the completion of all course requirements for NC EMT, Advanced EMT or Paramedic and have valid EMT, Advanced EMT or Paramedic credentials issued by the NC Office of EMS. CPR certification is required. EMT's or AEMT's that are enrolled in a NC Paramedic course and in good standing with the teaching institution will also be considered for open ALS positions. Successful applicants must be insurable under the County's automobile insurance policy at regular rates and continued adherence to the currently established Emergency Services dress code is required.
