



A telemedicine visit is available to established patients of the Surry County Health and Nutrition Center to patients of all ages – from newborns to adults. You must be in North Carolina or Virginia at the time of your visit.

SCHNC telemedicine visits allow you to have a live video chat with a qualified healthcare provider at a time scheduled for you. All you need is a camera-enabled tablet, smart phone or computer with internet connection. Examples of visits that may be scheduled as a telemedicine appointment are:

- Musculoskeletal concerns
- Minor cuts and scrapes
- Minor burns
- Insect bites
- Anxiety/Depression
- Refill visits
- Method change consults for birth control
- Vaginal discharge/burning/itching
- Cold, cough and bronchitis
- Coronavirus
- Conjunctivitis/pink eye
- Flu symptoms, for patients 5 and older
- Lower back pain
- Newborn worries, including feeding
- Seasonal allergies
- Sinus and upper respiratory infections
- Skin conditions, including rashes and lice
- Upset stomach, including constipation and diarrhea
- Behavioral Health services including ADHD/ADD medication follow up

Children with the following conditions should be seen in the office:

- Ear infection
- Fever, especially in young children
- Flu symptoms, for kids under 5
- Pneumonia
- Strep throat
- Urinary tract infection (UTI)
- Wheezing
